


STEP 1 Fast/Slow Animals (Lesson 5)

- Copy and cut <u>Fast/Slow</u> <u>Animal Cards</u> (pg. 221). Place cards face down on table.
- Have children echo-clap "clippity, cloppity" rhythm below.
- Allow each child to turn over a Fast/Slow Animal card.
- If card depicts a fast animal, lead child to clap the "clippity, cloppity" rhythm fast. For a slow animal, lead child to clap rhythm slowly.
- Repeat activity until all children have had a turn. Continue play using repeated rhythms from other Christmas Journey songs.



- along solid outer lines.
- Write child's name on back of each head and keep them for the next lesson.

Tip: Use brown index stock if children don't have time to color camels.



STEP 3 Saddle Up (Lesson 8)

- Provide children with their Camel Heads (from Step 2) a wooden paint stick and glue.
- Help children glue Camel Heads back to back and insert the end of paint stick between the camel "necks" to secure.
- Staple or glue Camel Head around the edges and write child's name on the paint stick with marker.
- Allow glue to dry and keep for future lessons.

STEP 2 Make a Camel Head (Lesson 7)
